WB John A. Stitely, Hiram Award Recipient, Headlines 2017 Awards Nite

The **Hiram Award**, the highest honor that can be bestowed at the local Lodge level, was awarded to Worshipful Brother John A. Stitely at Braden's Annual Awards Night held Nov 30th, 2017.

A 46-year member of the Craft, WB Stitely was raised in 1971 at Tri Lumen Lodge #18 in Oskaloosa IA. He was a member of Iowa City (IA) Lodge #4, and Mizpah Lodge #639 in Cedar Rapids IA, where he served as Worshipful Master in 2000. He moved to the Twin Cities in 2002 and joined Braden Lodge in 2003, rising through the chairs to become Master of the Lodge in 2009.

In nominating WB Stitely for the award, WM Jeff Koltveit cited John's integral role in bringing the Lodge together, and improving the level of ritual and education at our Lodge.

During 2017, we learned of three Brothers who have laid down their working tools to journey to the Celestial Lodge:

• **Brother Peter G Spindler:** Born in St Paul in 1926, Br Spindler was raised as a Master Mason at Braden Lodge on 12/10/1949, and remained a member of Braden for 69 years. After serving in the Navy in WWII, he attended Macalaster College and worked for Cargill Inc for 35 years. He was 94 when he died on 1/03/2017.

• **Brother Stuart H Steinman:** Born in St Paul in 1923, Br Steinman was raised in Braden Lodge on 6/14/1956, remaining a Mason for 61 years. He was an owner of William & Stuart Jewelry and Tread-Aerobic Treadmills. He died at age 90 after a long battle with dementia on 4/01/2017.

• **Brother Gerald E Carlson:** Born in St Paul in 1958, Br Carlson was raised as a Master Mason at Como Park Lodge on 11/20/1993, and remained a Mason for 21 years. He was a musician in local bands and taught video production at Hastings High School. He died 1/01/2014 at the age of 55 after a lifelong battle with depression. (We did not learn of his death until June 2017.)
